ITINERARY

Day One: Friday October 30th, 2020

Arrival at Ben Gurion airport: pick up around noon: tour **Old Jaffa** (Jonah's story – 'you can run but you cannot hide'), **Old Port** and **Simon the Tanner's house**. (God doesn't have favorites) **Tel Aviv**, beach, markets. **Welcome dinner and Orientation** (special Sabbath eve dinner).

Overnight: Leonardo City Tower Hotel Tel Aviv

Day Two: Saturday October 31, 2020

Travel north via Caesarea to aqueduct and see ancient Mosaics dating back to 5th century. Dip your feet in the Mediterranean Sea. On to Mt Carmel to attend Shabbat Services at Kehillat Ha Carmel Messianic Congregation. Lunch & tour at a Druze Village. Visit Muhraka "The place of burning", which is considered the Biblical site where the prophet Elijah won victory over the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:16-45). FABULOUS view over the Jezreel valley & beyond for photos & special time of prayer. Drive to Tiberias.

Day Three: Sunday November 1st, 2020

Capernaum "Leaving Nazareth, he (Yeshua) went and lived in Capernaum. From that time he began to preach" (Matthew 4: 13,17). Visit the ruins of Capernaum, the home of Yeshua (Jesus) as well as the apostles

Peter, Andrew, James and John and the tax collector Matthew. Tour **Magdala**, believed to be the birthplace of Mary of Magdalene. Visit the **ancient 'Jesus' boat** museum at Kibbutz Nof Ginosaur; worship on **Faith Boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee followed by **St. Peter's lunch**. Afternoon nature walk through **Banais nature reserve.** This is one of Israel's most beautiful sites with a spectacular waterfall and the place where Yeshua called Peter 'The Rock'. Free evening in Tiberias – promenade, shopping

Dinner and Overnight: Daria on the Sea of Galilee

Day Four: Monday November 2, 2020

Nazareth village tour (sheep, grapevines, woodworking, reconstructed 1st century synagogue); and Cana (Jewish wedding teaching). Yardenit Baptism (Messianic Mikvah & teaching on ritual water immersion). Opportunities to be baptized (Messianic mikvah) in the Jordan River.

Dinner and Overnight: Daria on the Sea of Galilee

Day Five: Tuesday November 3, 2020

Early morning **tree planting** (JNF forest). Visiting female **IDF soldiers at Northern Border**. Pizza lunch . **Hamat Gader (Hot Springs)**, crocodile farm and parrot (tookie) show. Continue driving towards the Dead Sea, passing Jericho en route.

Dinner and Overnight: David Hotel Dead Sea

Day Six: Wednesday November 4, 2020

Take a float in the salt waters of the **Dead Sea** (in Hebrew Yam Hamelach – Salt Sea) – the lowest place on earth & cover yourself in the mineral-rich mud. Take a cable car up to **Masada** - an ancient fortress occupying a breathtaking, strategic location high on a flat plateau above the Dead Sea. Many Israeli soldiers are sworn in here because Masada is a symbol of heroism. On to **Ein Gedi** ("spring of the goat") - a desert oasis with waterfalls, pools of water and two large streams where David hid from King Saul. Stop at **Qumran** - Home of Dead Sea scrolls. On to Genesis Land, situated in the heart of the Judean desert, where a train of camels will lead you to Abraham's tent to enjoy some Bedouin style hospitality. Drive to Jerusalem.

Dinner and Overnight: Crowne Plaza Jerusalem hotel

Day Seven: Thursday November 5, 2020

Mt. of Olives overview; bus to Kotel (Wailing Wall), Western Wall tunnel tour, walking through Muslim and Christian quarters of the Old City of Jerusalem into the Jewish quarter (Temple Institute), to Christ Church Café & Jaffa gate. Evening: Return after dinner for the Night Spectacular Sound and Light Show at the Citadel of David.

Day Eight: Friday November 6, 2020

Yad Vashem – Holocaust Memorial & Garden of Righteous among the nations. Friends of Zion museum. Worship & communion at the Garden tomb. To Yad Hashmona (Israel's only Messianic village). Evening: S.E.E. Israel Symposium. Special worship, speakers & Israeli Folk dance
